Important update

We are writing to inform you about the precautionary steps and contingency plans we are taking as a business to ensure that we are able to continue providing our services to you, particularly in the event that we are forced to close our office should the situation regarding Covid-19 deteriorate further. These plans and steps will enable us to rapidly adapt and continue to operate as close to 'business as usual' as possible.

Health and Wellbeing

Although we have very little face to face contact with our clients and the public throughout all our surveying services, on-site or office, we understand, and mirror, the concerns of our employees and business contacts about Covid 19 and its continuing spread and are keen to protect the health and safety of staff, clients, suppliers and all our families by closely following the ongoing advice and recommendations by The Government - Public Health England.

We have outlined some of the specific actions we have taken below:

All staff are strictly utilising personal cold and flu prevention measures to avert catching and spreading Covid-19 by:

- Washing hands more often with soap and water – doing this for at least 20 seconds
- Washing hands on getting home or into work
- Using hand sanitiser if soap and water are not available
- Covering our mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve (not hands) when coughing or sneezing
- Putting used tissues directly in a bin immediately afterwards and washing our hands afterwards
- Avoiding close contact with people who have symptoms of coronavirus
- Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces
- Trying not to touch our eyes, nose and mouth
- Trying to keep a 2 metre distance between another person as much as possible.

Remote working

As part of our preparation we have extended the systems and processes we already have in place to enable as many of our staff as possible to work remotely.

Most of our communications are electronic, but in the event of an office closure, any post will be checked as often as possible, but with remote working, our ability to respond by post may take a little longer than would normally be the case.
